What You'll Learn:

- Read the shot at a glance: when a BHE pivot (bigger pre-aim) cancels squirt, and when an FHE pivot (smaller pre-aim) lets swerve finish the job.
- Keep your original aim: apply tip offset by pivoting (BHE or FHE) instead of re-aiming the whole shot.
- Build your personal BHE/FHE matrix to quickly apply English to any shot realtime.
- Convert knowledge to position: quicker decisions, cleaner contacts, better shape for the next ball.
- Learn what the Natural Pivot point is for YOUR break and playing cues.
- Predict throw simply: understand when it matters and how your pivot + speed choice handles it.

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Course Highlights

- English without second-guessing: BHE/FHE pivots you can use in real time.
- Throw made simple: why some cuts over- or under-cut—and how your pivot choice and speed fix it.
- When you can ignore it: follow/draw near the pocket, correct gearing, or a firmer hit.
- Fast confidence: short, targeted table drills that stick and show up in real racks.

Schedule at a Glance

Day One (2 hours) — Required*

- Skill check (≈ 1 hr): quick baseline to find your biggest gains.
- Video analysis (≈ 1 hr): three angles to clean up habits that make English miss.
- Foundation check: Set–Pause–Finish–Freeze (or your equivalent).

Day Two (≈ 3 hours)

- English & Throw lab: learn and rep BHE vs FHE choices so they're automatic.
- Real-shot transfer: turn those pivots into pocketed balls and position you can trust.
- Take-home: a personalized notebook with your best cues and reminders.
